Founded in 1970, the Pardee RAND Graduate School uses a multidisciplinary curriculum that emphasizes research methods drawn from mathematics, economics and the social sciences. Students and faculty examine a wide range of policy issues including health, education, energy, environmental issues, public safety, labor, population and workforce demographics, as well as national and international security. PRGS students also work on active RAND policy research projects. This requirement, known as "On-the-Job Training," ensures that graduates are exposed to a wide variety of policy areas, research methods, colleagues, and clients. By the time they graduate, most fellows have accumulated the equivalent of at least two years of job experience in policy analysis and policy consulting.
